



Royal Astronomical Society of Canada – Edmonton Centre

Be it resolved that the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada – Edmonton Centre set forth the following objects:

1. To stimulate interest and to educate the public in astronomy and related sciences.
2. To acquire and maintain equipment, libraries and other property necessary for the pursuit of its aims.
3. To publish material containing information on the progress of astronomy and the work of the Centre.
4. To contribute financially to institutions that are “qualified donees” as recognized in subsection 149.1(1) of the Income Tax Act, and to provide voluntary assistance to organizations that engage in the study and advancement of astronomy and related sciences.
5. To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, lands and buildings and all other property, real and personal, which the Centre for the purpose of carrying out its objects may from time to time think proper to acquire, and to sell, assign, sublet, surrender, turn to account, or dispose of, such property, or any part thereof, and to erect upon any such land any buildings for the purposes of the Centre, and to alter, add to, or improve any buildings erected on such land.
